MEETING LOCATIONS AND DESCRIPTIONS

1. EARLYBIRD RECOVERY CENTRAL / ST. STEPHEN'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH/ Speak Your Peace -- St. Stephen's Episcopal Church, Havens Center, 1827 W. Alabama, between Shepherd and Woodhead on the south side of W. Alabama. The Havens Center is two buildings west of the main church building. Use the side entrance.
2. BERING MEMORIAL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH --1440 Harold in the Montrose, one block south of Westheimer and one block east of Mandell. From Shepherd, take Westheimer (east) to Mulberry (turn south) to Hawthorne (turn east). The rear parking lot for the church is immediately on the south side of the street or park on the streets around the church.
