The only cost is your usual long-distance rate (for those with cell phones, there may be no charge as many are during the evening hours). MEETING LOCATIONS AND DESCRIPTIONS

1. Early Bird Recovery Central / St. Stephen's Episcopal Church / Speak Your Peace – St. Stephen's Episcopal Church, 1827 W. Alabama, between Shepherd and Woodhead on the south side of W. Alabama. All meetings (the Early Bird meetings and the Sunday night meeting) are in the Havens Center, which is two buildings west of the main church building on W. Alabama. Use the side entrance. *Contact for the Early Bird meetings is Robby M. (832/216-2003). Contact for the Sunday night meeting is Jim T. (832/868-0524).*
2. Bering Memorial United Methodist Church – 1440 Harold in the Montrose, one block south of Westheimer and one block east of Mandell. From Shepherd, take Westheimer (east) to Mulberry (turn south) to Hawthorne (turn east). The rear parking lot for the church is immediately on the south side of the street, or park on the streets around the church. The rear entrance for the church is under the green canopy (this is the only open entrance, and you will have to press the buzzer on your right as you face the door to gain admittance to the building); enter and take your first right for the elevator or stairs; go to the second floor and turn right. 3. From Shame to Grace / New Beginnings – St. Cyril of Alexandria Catholic Church - 10503 Westheimer, at the corner of Westheimer and Rogerdale, one block past Beltway 8. The weekday meetings are in Rm 223. The Saturday morning meeting is in Rm. 222. Both meetings are in the parish education building located next to the church. *Contact for the weekday meetings is Gilbert R. (713/299-5755). Take Highway 290 West to the Jones Road exit; go right on Jones Road. The church is located about a quarter of a mile on the right-hand side of Jones Road. Take the first driveway off of Jones and go straight to the back. The Scout Building is the last building on the left-hand side in the back. The meeting is upstairs.
